



GAME DAY SAFETY GUIDELINES

Families, coaches, players and staff,

Our top priority is to play our games in the safest way possible for our players, referees and coaches. We appreciate the adjustments you have made to handle recent changes and are grateful for your patience as each one of us work through these times and plan accordingly for the safest way possible for our players, referees and staff.

The guidelines below should be followed by all visiting teams, home teams, referees, parents and coaching staff.

Parent/Guardian Responsibilities:

1. Ensure your child is healthy, and check your child's temperature before visiting our facility for the game.
2. Carpooling is highly discouraged.
3. Ensure your child's equipment (cleats, ball, shin guards etc.) are sanitized before and after every game.
4. Notify your coach immediately if your child becomes ill for any reason.
5. Do not assist your coach with equipment before or after the game.
6. Be sure your child has necessary sanitizing products with them at every game.
7. Follow proper precautions (i.e. was/sanitize hands, avoid touching face, wear a mask if necessary, etc.).
8. Social distancing should take place on the sideline. This includes players/coaches on the & parents/guardians/siblings/etc. during their visit to the facility.

Player/Staff/Administrator Responsibilities:

1. Take your temperature before coming to the game to ensure you are fever free.
2. Wash hands thoroughly before and after the game.
3. Bring, and use, hand sanitizer with you at all time.
4. Do not touch or share anyone else's equipment, water, food or bags.
5. Practice social distancing, place bags and equipment at least 6 feet apart.
6. Wash and sanitize all equipment before and after every game.
7. No group celebrations, high-5s, hugs, handshakes, fist-bumps, etc.
8. All participants should be required to bring and fill their own water containers/bottles and they can't be shared.
9. Leave team area immediately following end of game.
10. Player's cards, game reports should be handled by one designated person only.
11. There will be no benches on the sidelines.
12. It is recommended to please limit 2 parents/guardians per player.
